

The Modern Classroom Experience

As soon as you enter the classroom, you will see that the layout of the desks is different than the way a Traditional Classroom is laid out.

You will see that the classroom experience is more of a personal 'consultation' with you and the instructor. This 'one-on-one' feel is possible because your instructor will use the entire time to guide you and your fellow classmates through your learning plans. This extra personal attention can occur because the Modern Classroom incorporates two instructors. The second instructor's job is to just deliver the lecture portion of the course via video and headphones.

Your 'consulting' instructor will assign the appropriate lectures, labs, reading and quizzes required to complete your learning plan and will work with you as you apply what you've learned on anything you need help with.

You will be able to work at a pace that you are comfortable with and on a learning plan designed specifically for you. You can take as much or as little time as you may need for any assigned topic.

Your 'lecturing' instructor delivers the 'context' for each topic at a pace YOU control - if you don't understand a concept or point, you can pause, rewind and listen again or ask your 'consulting' instructor to explain it to you.

The instructor's first task in the morning is to work with you to develop a personalized learning plan. In order to do this the instructor will ask you to complete an online skills assessment before reviewing the results with you.



Select the learning lessons prescribed to you. Watch and listen to a pre-recorded lesson led by an expert instructor. Watching this is like standing beside your own personal instructor as they walk and talk you through each step in the lesson. Repeat each lesson as many times as you want.

Complete your pre-learning assessment and lesson labs to practice what you've learned. You may repeat each "lab" as many times as you want. Learn and practice at YOUR speed, not the speed of others.

Listen to your lessons with headphones. Allowing you to focus on content without distracting yourself or others with noise.

You will follow along with an exercise book. It clearly lays out the instructions for all of your exercises.

If you're anxious about being new to the computer or new to a particular application, your instructor will help you get started. Your instructor is in the classroom the entire time. If you need help, just ask. Your instructor is an expert in the topic you are learning. Your instructor can focus on whatever you need, whenever you need it.

Upon the completion of the day, there will be a post assessment to measure the knowledge. In order to receive your learning credit this post assessment is mandatory. In addition, if there are courses that you would like to attend that are not offered within the timeframe you require, you have the option of enrolling into one of our public scheduled classes.
